- Child Safe Officer is Gordon Keefe
 - Senior Club have appointed three Child Safe Officers this season
 - There is a report form on the website, or call/email me direct.
 - If you believe a child is in immediate danger, call the police
- Member Protection Information Officer is Gordon Keefe
- Provides support if there are complaints/grievances
- Child safety is one of the most important roles a Coach and Manager will play

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Coach's role

- Pre-season
 - Collect kit
- Pre-training
 - Planning and preparation
 - Communication
- Training
 - Match review: historical and upcoming
 - Team goals
 - Individual player development (player and person)
- Pre-match
 - Team line-up in PlayHQ ([Link](#))
- Match day
 - Team line-up for scorers (even if in PlayHQ)
 - Ground set up
 - Warm up
 - Team roles
 - Break
 - Wrap up
- Post match
 - Reflect
 - Record
 - Disputes



Coaching fundamentals

- Preparation and presentation
- PlayHQ administration
- Resources
 - CA Coach App
 - YouTube
 - PlayHQ
 - CricketACT
 - Other coaches
 - Committee members
- During the game
 - Encourage and support – positive cricket experience
 - Address issues early with the other coach (balls, helmets)

Manager's role

(Keep the team informed
and running smoothly)

- Pre-season
 - Meet with Coach: agree on roles and training time
 - Book ground for training
 - Email parents: training details, what and when you'll communicate, ask everyone how they can help
 - Set up scorers and umpires roster
- Pre-match
 - Game day information to parents
 - Confirm scorers and umpires
 - Organise fill-ins for any absences
- Match day
 - Open and close toilets (home games)
 - Greet other team
 - Provide book and pencils to scorers
 - Cold packs/table and shade for scorers/lollies
 - Coordinate/round up kids if needed
- Post match
 - Enter results and player stats into PlayHQ (coach may want to do this)
